 - Speaker Series: Topic Suggestions -
 - Results of last Speaker Series=Developmental Assets and Aces (Across the Ages), Naloxone training- "Everybody doing it?" Twenty total in attendance
 - October 2nd at the Rec Department- A great event with about 20 attendees receiving a Narcan kit.
 - An overall positive evaluation was incredibly positive around developmental assets and Narcan. Potential topics- mental health- a high issue, and dealing with substance abuse around the house.
 - The event went a little later than expected, but the information was well received.
 - Data Collection-Readiness DONE—Roll Call-Completed-Requesting DEA Take Back Day, Status of Dropbox, and Compliance Checks
 - The community maintained a readiness score of six during the pandemic.
 Last month, DPI attended two Roll Call sessions with Decatur Police, which allowed DPI to get feedback about what is happening in the community.
 - We do not hear issues about the open container law.
 - There are available units when there is a need on the Square.
 - Special events around the community.
 - Informal impression report of a potential resurgence of meth.
 - The older population that DPI cannot get data on but should keep in mind.
 - Sergeant Binder will reach out about the DEA Take-Back Day. The
 department may not have the capacity as they are not open yet, and the lock
 box is locked, but we will discuss further offline.
 - Currently, the lockbox may stay locked for a while.
 - Compliance checks- Special units will be the leader in this. Terrie will follow up offline.
