- WELCOME WITH VISION AND MISSION
 - Vision- Promote a healthy Decatur, free of the negative effects of alcohol and other drugs on youth and families. Mission- Systematically implement evidence-based strategies to promote the behavioral health of youth and families.

- Youth Action Team Activities
 - o YAT has been meeting after school at the fire station as a convenient meeting location.
 - IOAD- On August 31st, YAT did a tabling in the cafeteria. The youth had ten cups and asked their peers to pick a cup. The cups state 'fentanyl or no' because 6 in 10 pills sold on the street had fentanyl in them. Provided an opportunity to teach on the Good Samaritan law and discussed Narcan.
 - On 9/8, they tabled again, asking their peers to provide healthy coping skills on a sticky note.
 988 is the suicide helpline number and September is suicide awareness month. Ended up with
 250 kids filling out notecards.
 - The youth also attended the Georgia Teen Institute Annual Leadership Conference in Duluth.
 The kids learned about strategic planning and developed an action plan based on the data for the community. Thank you, Mr. Sprull, for providing the bus.
 - YAT Justice Nasar developed the vaping poster with a 3-5% click-through rate. The cute animals and sad dogs helped the ad to appeal to kids. DPI will be designing another one with a similar look for Cinema Drive with the topic of drinking and driving.

 - Gary Menard Phase 1- just received the approval to purchase Narcan and is waiting on a signature to purchase and move to distribution. After that is completed, phase 2 will determine what needs to be done with additional funding.
 - Fire Department- Gary Menard
 - Recently had an overdose where Narcan was used in addition to CPR. Trying to teach people to get Narcan but also teach CPR.
 - Terrie- Potentially hosting a Narcan (Naloxone) training on October 29th utilizing *This is Not About Drugs* and helping individuals be CPR aware.

 - LGBTQ+ Support
 - DPI is considering hosting a small parenting session- Coffee Chat, about how to decrease risk factors with their LGBTQ+ youth.
